

# Brief introduction on IKI JET Project

- Donors** International Climate Initiative (IKI) of the Federal Ministry for Economic Affairs and Climate Action (BMWK) and jointly financed by the EU Commission
- Objectives**
- Supporting key stakeholders in the coal regions to plan and implement just energy transition pathways across the region, from an unsustainable, coal-dependent energy system to a net-zero emission & climate resilient energy system. At the same time, the Project will contribute to environmental protection, inclusive and sustainable economic development and create decent job creation in some coal regions in Asia, Africa and Latin America, through peer-to-peer exchanges, training and information sharing
  - **State agencies and related organizations in Vietnam** will be able to integrate or apply the just energy transition approaches developed and delivered by the Project.
- Scope** The Project will be implemented in 7 countries, including **VIET NAM**, Indonesia, Thailand, Mongolia, South Africa, Colombia and Chile. **In Viet Nam, the Project's focus will be Quang Ninh region.**
